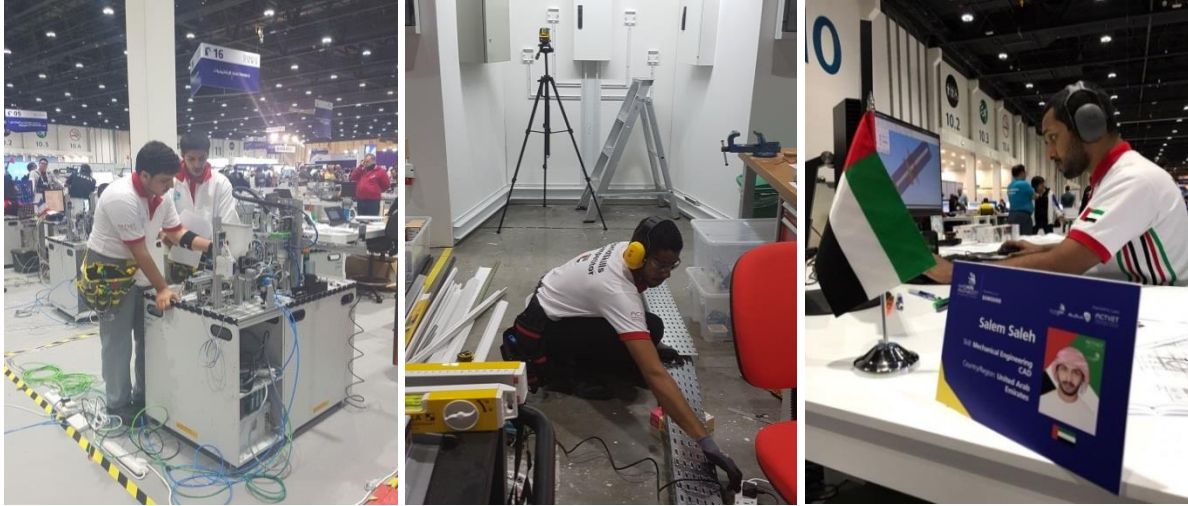
- Students from the EMET program participated in the Global Hybrid Electric Challenge/ Egypt- March 2018. The students received the:
